## **REQUEST PROCESSES FOR SECURITY OFFICERS**

Kronos2 account holders must appoint two or more persons to function as Security Officers on behalf of the account holder. A person who has been registered by Danmarks Nationalbank as Security Officer has authority to:

- 1. send requests regarding user access to Kronos2 for the account holder's users. For this, the form "Form: Create Kronos2 user" is used.
- send requests regarding changes to user access permissions in Kronos2 for the account holder's users. For this, the form "Form: Changes to existing Kronos2 user" is used.
- send requests regarding removal of user access permissions in Kronos2 for the account holder's users. For this, the form "Form: Removal of existing Kronos2 user" is used.
- send requests regarding to which extent the account holder wishes to apply the 4-eyes principle. For this, the form "Form: Registration/changes to bank set-up in Kronos2 -
  - 4-eyes principle and optional SWIFT messages" is used.
- 5. send requests regarding whether the account holder wishes to receive specific, optional SWIFT messages (relevant only for account holders using SWIFT). For this, the same form "Form: Registration/changes to bank set-up in Kronos2 4-eyes principle and optional SWIFT messages" is used.

All request forms must be sent to kronos2@nationalbanken.dk with the subject: "Security Officer request". The e-mail <u>must</u> be sent from the Security Officer's **own personal work email address** as registered by Danmarks Nationalbank.

When Danmarks Nationalbank has checked all prerequisites, the request will be processed as quickly as possible. When a request is finalised, a confirmation will be sent to <u>all</u> registered Security Officers of the account holder in question.
